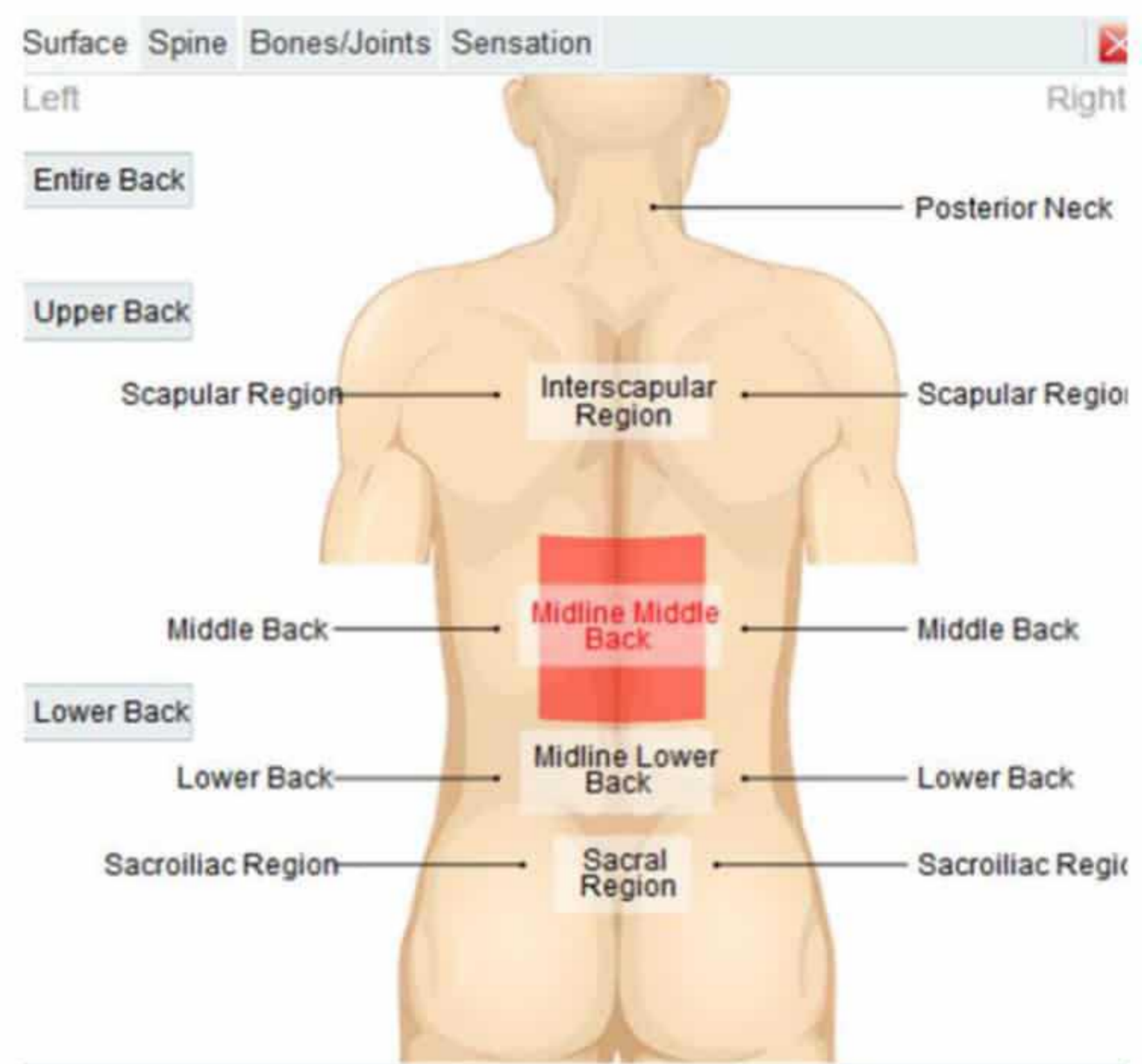

Mr ROGER N LONG is a 60 year old male patient here today complaining of back pain. He has acute back pain. The problem is intermittent. The patient reports radiation of pain.
